

ORDINANCE NO. 2019-08-15 B

Parking on Town Streets during Winter

Whereas, the Town Council of the Town of Mantua, Box Elder County, State of Utah, having previously adopted ORDINANCES OF MANTUA TOWN and

Whereas, the Town Council has determined that, for the general safety and welfare of the residents of Mantua, there is a need to establish an ordinance concerning parking on the streets in the Town of Mantua during the winter season.

Now, THEREFORE, the Town Council of the Town of Mantua Utah hereby adopts, passes and establishes the following:

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND CONTROLLING THE PARKING AND LEAVING OF VEHICLES AND OTHER ITEMS ON THE STREETS DURING THE WINTER SEASON WITHIN THE TOWN OF MANTUA.

Section O. Ordinance 2015-10-15A is hereby repealed and replaced with the following:

Section 1. Night Parking.

It is unlawful for the driver or owner of any vehicle or any other item which would hinder or obstruct the free and normal passage of traffic and or the efficient and safe removal of snow from streets of Mantua during following times. From November 1 of each year and April 1 of the following year, between the hours of twelve o'clock (12:00 a.m.) midnight and six o'clock (6:00 a.m.) the next day. Those needing to stop briefly for the purpose of loading or unloading passengers may do so, but not to exceed five (5 minutes). This subsection does not apply to emergency vehicles or personnel or utility vehicles when responding to emergencies or school buses when loading or discharging of passengers.

Section 2. Hour limitation.

Any driver or owner of any vehicle or item which may hinder or obstruct the free and normal passage of traffic or the safe and efficient removal of snow from Mantua streets, alley or property of the Town of Mantua who parks or leaves such in violation of this ordinance for a period exceeding 48 hours during the times established in Section 1, shall have such vehicle or item impounded or removed at the owners expense. If a vehicle or item is parked or left in such a location as to present a safety hazard or to block the passage of vehicles or snow removal equipment such may be impounded or removed immediately at the owner's expense regardless of the time of year or time of day.

Section 3. Penalties.

Violation of this ordinance shall be punishable as an infraction with a fine of not less than the following amounts:

First offense: \$75.00

Any subsequent offenses: \$100.00

Section 4. Applicability:

This Ordinance shall repeal ordinance 2015-10-15 A and any other ordinance, resolution or part there of being in conflict thereof shall be null and void.




