Suggested Changes to Land Use Code – Harper Johnson

Harper Johnson wanted to clarify the term's definitions of developer and subdivider to make things clearer. Harper and Pam clarified that the term 'shall' in ordinances means 'must'. Harper was going to gather more information and they could look into it later. He explained there were different things a developer and a subdivider were responsible for when they build on land. There will need to be a public hearing to change anything in the code, and there is a fire hydrant code that needs to be cleaned up.

Harper looked into the code that stated the required frontage to build a home and found it only said it had to be on a public road, not necessarily on a Mantua owned road. He does want it changed to be only on a Mantua owned road to streamline any potential utility issues in the future. The road to the South of 600 North isn't owned by the town or UDOT but by the property owner. Pam explained that if the owners came in with formal plans they could be 'grandfathered in'.

Pam added a topic of discussion, a new commission member as Don Wallentine resigned. She asked anyone for suggestions and to send them to the mayor. There was discussion about people they thought could fill the seat. Terry asked for them to think about it and give him a call.

Public Comment

Terry mentioned that he had been talked to about lighting on the flagpole. Harper reassured that it is being addressed. Terry also asked about any update cabins at the campground. Harper had talked to Jason and he is waiting for the architectural plans for the cabins. The commission and mayor discussed what else needs to be done with the fence, parking and the proposed lot line adjustment.

Darrell Duncan made a motion to adjourn, Tim Miles seconded.
